

SLPC ADOPTED PROVISIONS RELATING TO FINANCIAL MATTERS

Emergency Decision Making Scheme - Adopted 19.11.20.

The Clerk, in consultation with the Chairman, may spend up to £1500 plus VAT between monthly meetings for emergency decision making purposes without a formal decision to do so in a Council Meeting. The Chairman and another Councillor are required signatories and all spending must be reported at the next meeting of the Council.

Chairman's Allowance £200 Per Year - Adopted 19.11.20.

Chairman Allowance can be spent by the Chairman without prior approval of the Council and is reimbursable upon presentation of a receipt/invoice. The intended use of the allowance is for the Chairman, as a representative of the Council, to pay for tokens of appreciation etc in situations when the Council does not have the legal power to do so. For instance, if a parishioner helps the Council in some manner, the Chair can buy a modest gift as a token of the Council's appreciation.

Councillors Expenses

The Council will reimburse reasonable expenses incurred while on Council business upon presentation of an invoice or receipt. The mileage allowance is £0.45 per mile.
