- Local watercourses: The government has launched a consultation with the aim
  of strengthening the powers available for dealing with environmental offences in
  order to reduce water pollution. Our Avonvale River Action Group (ARAG) is a

- Wychavon has finished helping to fund fourteen months of excavation work by the County Archaeology Service at Milestone Ground in Broadway. Whilst now Broadway is known as the picturesque gateway to the Cotswolds recent findings suggest our ancestors considered it an even more significant settlement. From early pre-history through to the Anglo-Saxon era the number of artefacts found will take a couple of years to analyse and study; meanwhile the land will be sold for a new housing and sports development.
